Notice of Race

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

The notation '[NP]' in a rule in the NoR means that a breach of this rule will not be grounds for a protest by a board. This changes RRS 60.1.

1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.2. Racing rules will be changed as follows:

a) RRS 61.1(a) will be changed so, that when protesting about an incident in the racing area, a Boat shall display the red flag as described in RRS 61.1(a).

b) RRS 44.1. is changed so that the two turns penalty is replaced by a one turn penalty (see 10.2)

c) Appendix A8 is changed so that the long distance race breaks the ties (see 11.5)

The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

1.3. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

1.4. No national prescriptions will apply.

2. ADVERTISING

(DP) 2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

3. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

3.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the Micro Class.

3.2 CLASSIC DIVISION

To encourage all Micro sailors, every Micro boat build no later than 2008 may take part in Championship in specially set Classic Division. These boats will not be classified in General, Racer or Cruiser Rankings as long as they will not have valid Measurement Certificate

3.3. All Boats should present their WS identification plate. WS plates can be bought on site for a 75€ fee. To be ranked in the Euro Micro/World Championship, each skipper has to be a full member of a National Micro Cupper Class Association affiliated to IMCCA.

If the nation is not affiliated to IMCCA or didn't pay the annual fee; or if the skipper is not a full member of a National Micro Cupper Association, he can become an individual IMCCA membership paying annually fees of 60 € to IMCCA.

3.4 Eligible boats shall enter by completing the official entry form on the event website <http://microworlds2019.org/registration/> from September 1st, 2018 and paying the required fee. On-line entry will close 11.08.2019.

3.5 Late entries are subject to the late entry fee.

4. FEES

4.1. Required fees in Euro, including any local taxes are as follows:

- entry fee is 190 € per boat, paid before 10.9.2018

- entry fee is 200 € per boat, paid after 10.9.2018 and before 30.6.2019
- entry fee, paid after 30.06.2019: 250 €
- entry fees for support boats : 100 €

The entry fee includes: launching, berthing, free access and parking for the competitors, sailors dinner, souvenirs, if any.

4.2. INSTRUCTIONS how to pay

4.3. Entry fees will be not refunded.

5. SCHEDULE

5.1. Registration:

5.2. Opening ceremony:

5.4. Equipment inspection and event measurement:

5.5. Dates of racing :

Long distance is planned for Wednesday and will be adjusted according to weather forecast.

5.6. The scheduled time of the warning signal for practice race is 13:00, for the first race of all other days it is 10:00.

5.7. On the last day of the regatta, no warning signal shall be done after 15:00

5.8. Prize Giving

Friday, August 23th evening ca 20.00

6. MEASUREMENTS

6.1. Each boat shall produce a valid certificate except boats entered the event in Classic Division.

6.2. A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with class rules and Sailing Instructions. On the water or after arriving in harbour, a boat may be instructed by the race committee measurer to proceed immediately for inspection.

6.3. Crew members shall present boats, sails, and rigging for equipment control and stick to schedule, defined by the ranking number attributed at their arrival.

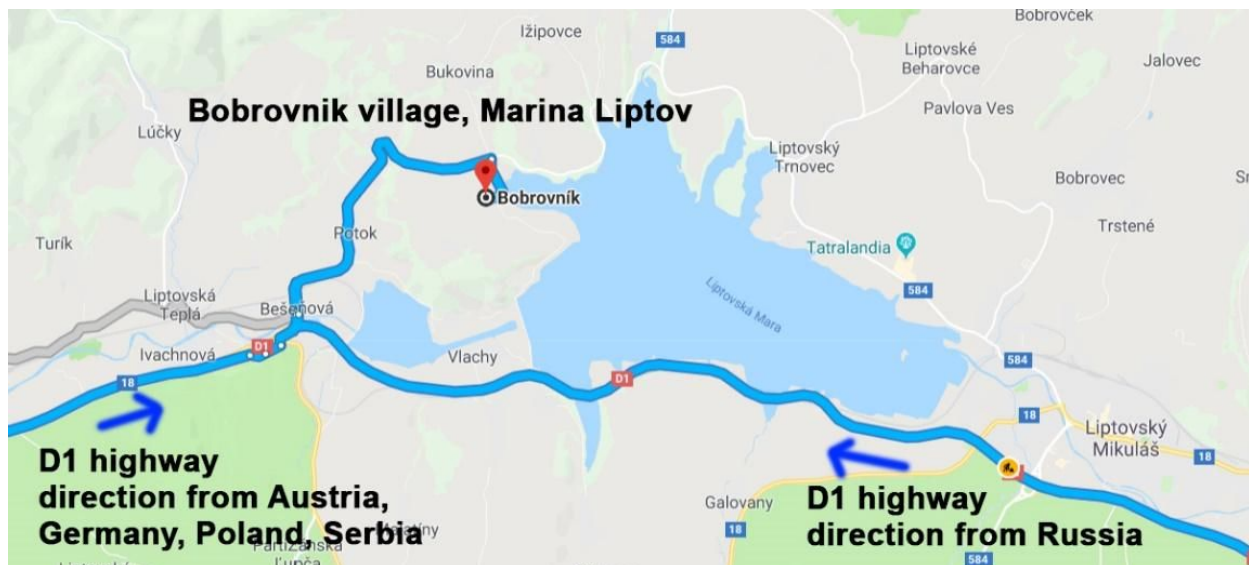
6.4. A boat chartered or loaned for an event may carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of her class rules.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1. Sailing Instructions will be available after 14:00 on August 16th, 2019 at the registration desk.

8. VENUE

8.2. The racing area will be the Liptovska Mara lake as shown below.



(NP) 9. THE COURSE

9.1. The courses to be sailed will be as follows:

- up-and-down short races with leeward gate, with target time about 60 for the first boat
- 1 long distance race of 20 to 25 nautical miles, finish for the last boat not later than 30 minutes after sunset. Shortened long distance race will be valid as long distance race if at least 50% of the distance is sailed.

9.2. The course for long distance race will be set according to actual weather conditions and wind direction.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1. Appendix P will apply

10.2. RRS 44.1. is changed so that the two turns penalty is replaced by a one turn penalty

10.3. Decisions of the International jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5

10.4. A jury on water process can be implemented according to the sailing instructions.

11. SCORING

11.1. There will be a General Ranking, from which the rankings for the Racer and Cruiser Division will be derived.

11.2. A separate Classic Division Ranking will be produced.

11.3. It is planned to sail 15 races and 3 races are required to be completed to validate the championship.

11.4. Discards

Every type of race can be discarded:

- a) When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- b) When from 4 to 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race score excluding her worst score.
- c) When 11 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race score excluding her two worst scores.

11.5. Tie breaks

Appendix A8 is changed so, that

a) In case of a tie, the tie will be broken for the better place in the long distance race

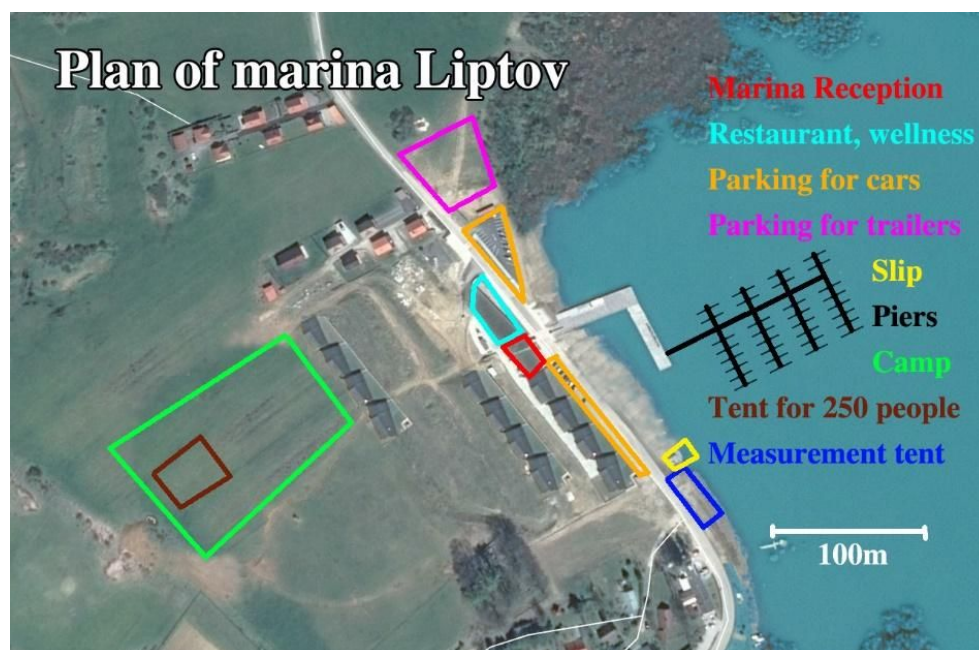
b) If the long distance race cannot separate the equally placed boats, further standard Appendix A8 will apply

12. *BERTHING*

12.1. Mooring will be in Marina Liptov from August 17th to 24th. An arrival before this slot is subject to acceptance by the organizer and could be subject of a payment

(DP)12.2. Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the Marina

12.3. Plan of Marina Liptov:



13. *HAUL OUT RESTRICTIONS*

(DP)13.1. boats shall not be hauled out during the event except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the Race Committee

14. *SUPPORT BOATS*

(DP, NP)14.1. Support boats shall be marked with national letters

15. *CHARTER OF BOATS*

15.1. There are charter boats available, for more information contact the organizer.

(DP)16. *RADIO COMMUNICATION*

16.1. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. (See Sailing Instructions)

16.2. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

17. PRIZES

17.1. Prizes will be given as follows:

- Prizes for the teams finishing 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the General Ranking
- Prizes for the teams finishing 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the Racer Division, Cruiser Division and Classic Division
- other Prizes may be awarded

18. INSURANCE

18.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.500.000€ per event or the equivalent

19. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

19.1. By entering, all competitors taking part in the regatta do so entirely at their own risk – see RRS 4, the decision to race – the organizing authority will not accept any responsibility for damage to equipment, injuries or death before, during or after the regatta.

20. MEDIA RIGHTS

20.1. By participating in the event competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.

20.2. Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment as specified by the Organizing Authority.

20.3. Competitors may be required for interviews at the regatta.

21. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

21.1. MEASUREMENT

Any non-certified set of sails can be certified on site before the competition for an administrative fee of 30€/sail.
